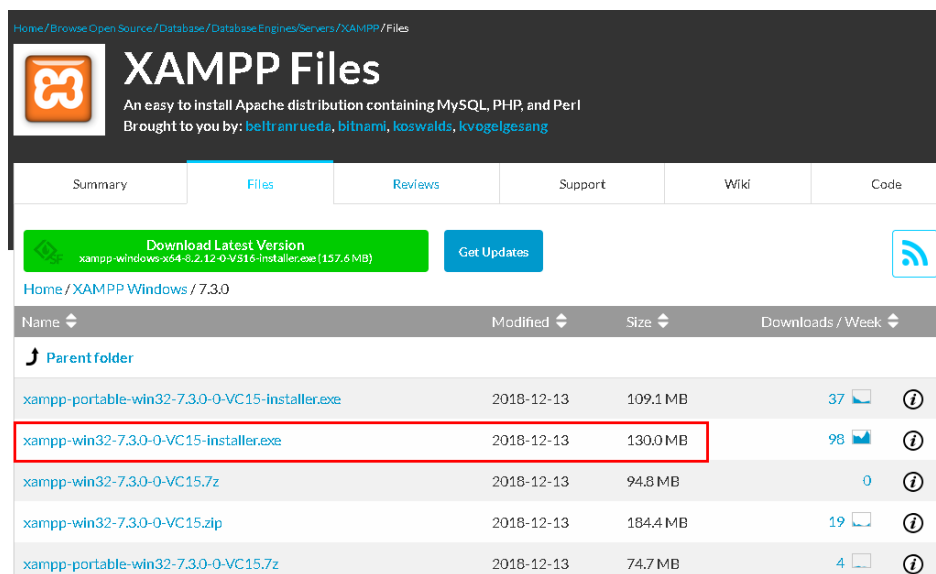


How To Setup EZ Data Logger Query Page for PHP Web

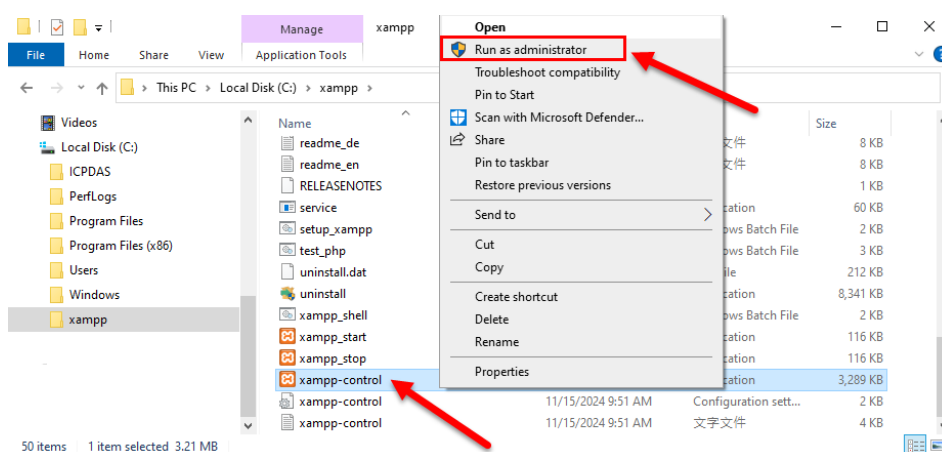

Step 1. Download XAMPP by the link and install it.

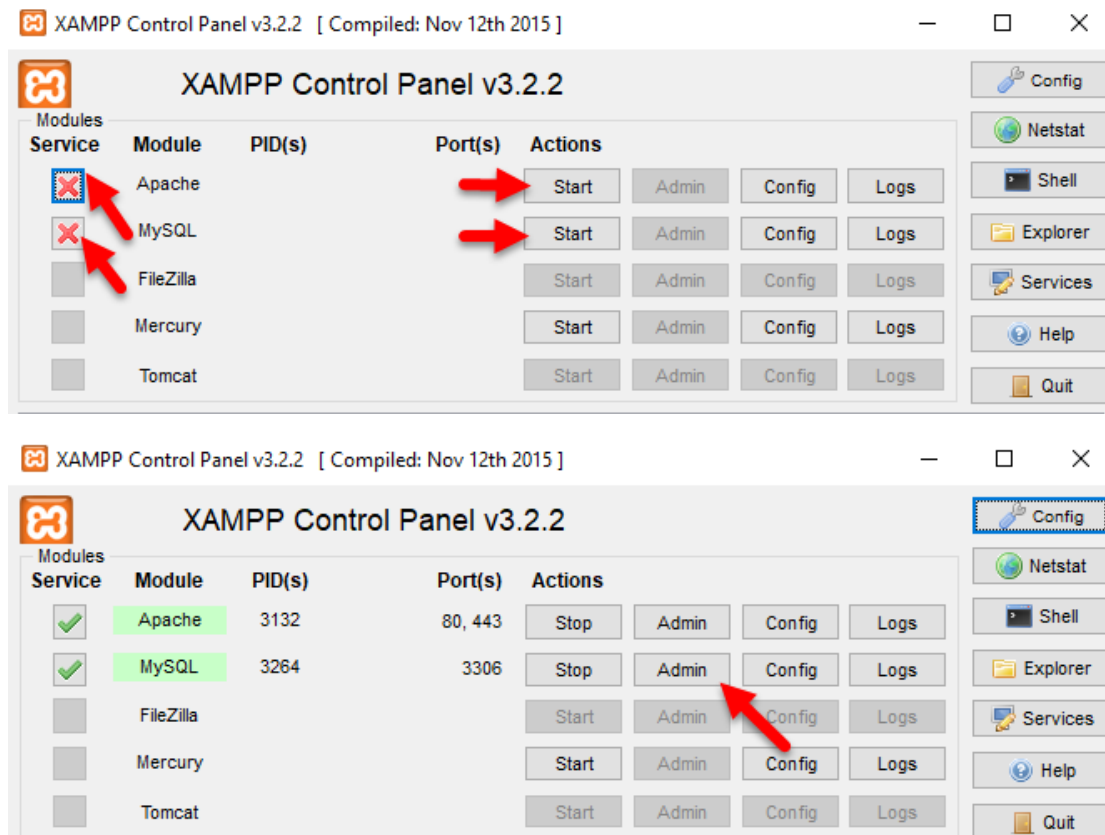

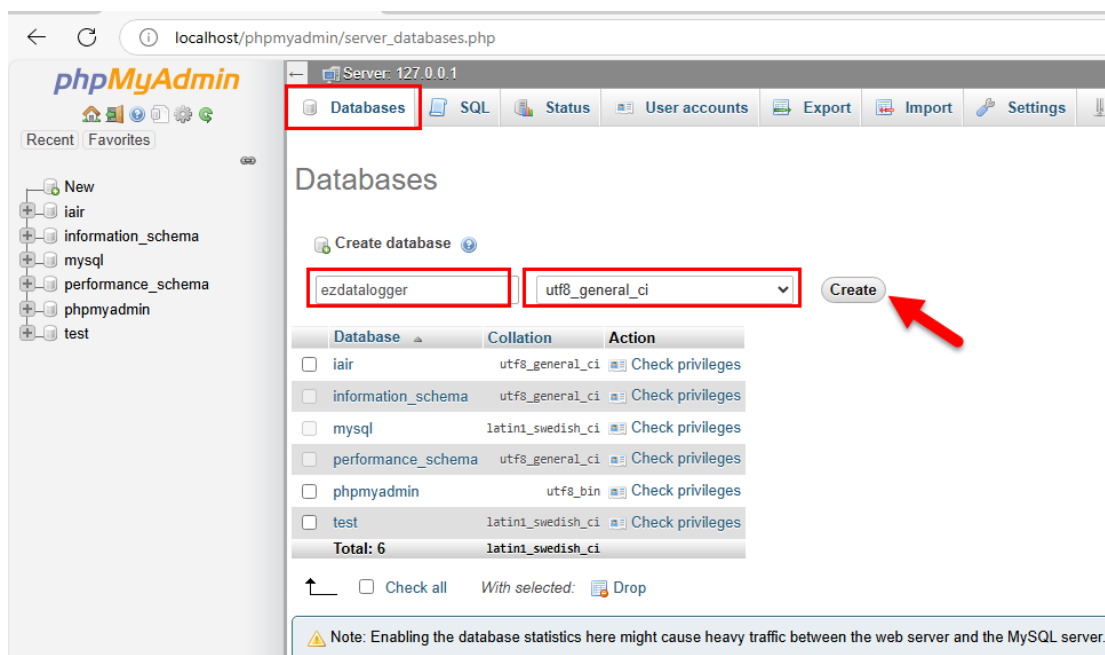
Step 2. Mouse right click xampp-control.exe and choose "Run as administrator"



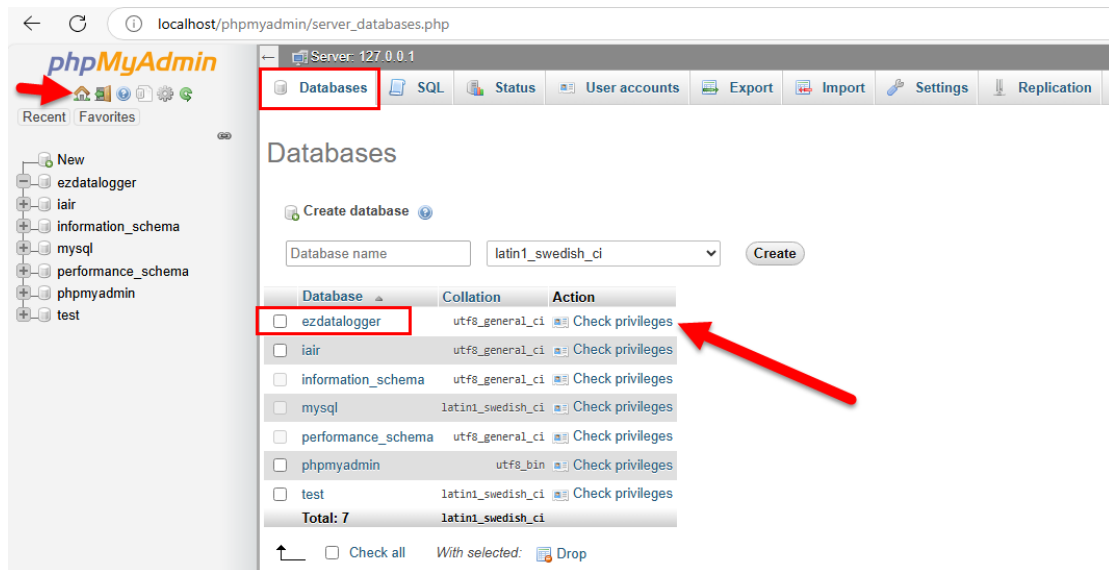
Step 3. Enable Apache and MySQL services. Start Apache and MySQL services. Then click MySQL Admin.



Step 4. Go to Database page. Input the database name for EZDataLogger.



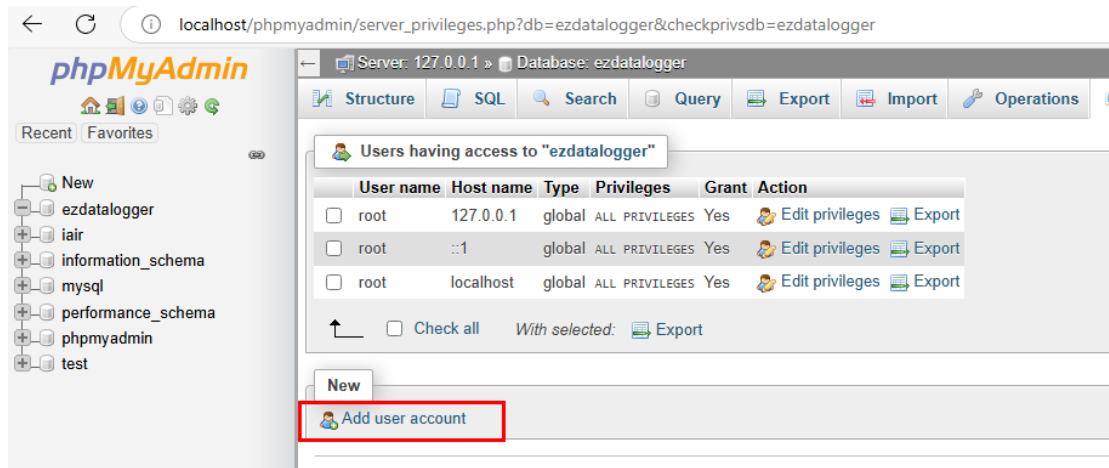
Step 5. Go to Database and click database privileges.

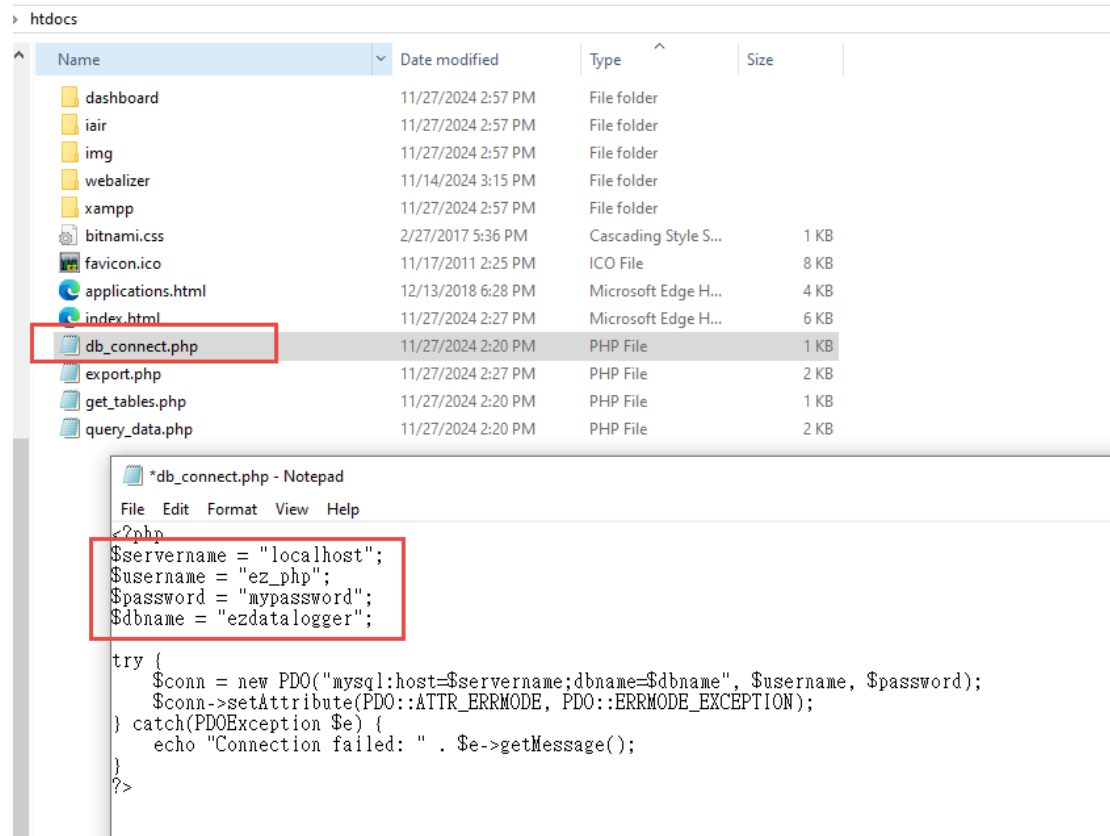
