For Windows Vista(x86, 32-bit) or Windows 7(x86, 32-bit)

Please do the following steps to install the ISaGRAF Ver. 3.

• Disable the "UAC" (User Account Control) for the operating system (Only the administrator can do that).

How to disable UAC?

Note: Only the administrator can modify the "UAC" setting.

1. From the **"Start"** menu, choose **"Control Panel"**, then **"User Accounts"**, then **"User Accounts"**, then click **"Turn User Account Control on or off"**.



2. Click **"Continue"** on the pop-up "UAC" dialog.
